On June 27, 2024, you were notified that a re-investigation was initiated to update the normal values and export prices of certain oil country tubular goods originating in or exported from the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu (Chinese Taipei), India, Indonesia, South Korea, Thailand, Türkiye and Vietnam (**OCTG II**).

Due to the complexity of the issues presented and the number of persons involved, the re-investigation has been extended and will now conclude by January 31, 2025.
