- Breakfast cereals, instant cereal beverage mixes, couscous meal mixes and snack foods (including muesli bars, granola bars and wholefood bars/balls, trail mixes) that are commercially prepared and retail packaged\*
- Bakery and bread mixes (including whole seeds) that are commercially prepared and retail packaged\*
- Commercially prepared and packaged herbal teas, with or without seeds (including loose leaf and teabags).
- Goods that are chemically processed and preserved such as with a Formalin Propionic Acid fixative, Formalin Acetic acid alcohol, Carnoy's fixative or ethanol.
- Fresh vegetables.
- Commercially manufactured frozen or freeze-dried food (perishable foodstuffs only).
- Frozen plant samples for plant research (including through the use of liquid nitrogen and freeze drying).
- Oils derived from vegetables or seed.
- Preserved or pickled.
- Goods that have been refined or extracted to obtain specific components from plant-based raw materials (including starch, lecithin, protein, cellulose, sugars and pigments).

İHRACAT GENEL MÜDÜRLÜĞÜNE

Malumları olduğu üzere, Avustralya Tarım, Su ve Çevre Bakanlığı tarafından 13 Ağustos 2020 yapılan duyuru ile “khapra beetle” böceği ile mücadele kapsamında tedbirlerin tedrici olarak uygulamaya konulacağı, ayrıca ülkemiz ile birlikte toplam 40 ülkenin hedef riskli ülke olduğu açıklanmıştır.

Bu itibarla, “yüksek riskli” olarak nitelenen ve bir örneği Ek-1’de yer alan ürünlere yönelik olarak 3 Eylül 2020 tarihinde yürürlüğe giren 1. ve 2. aşama tedbirleri, 30 Eylül 2021 tarihinde yürürlüğe giren 3. aşama tedbirler izlemiştir.

Bu çerçevede, ilgili Bakanlık tarafından 21 Nisan 2022 tarihinde yapılan yeni bir açıklama ile, 28 Nisan 2022 tarihinden itibaren “khapra beetle” böceği ile mücadele kapsamında bir örneğine Ek-2’de yer verilen aşağıdaki “diğer riskli ürün grupları” için 4. aşama ithalat tedbirlerinin yürürlüğe gireceği duyurulmuştur.

- Tohumlar (yüksek riskli ürünler hariç)
- Kuruyemişler (yüksek riskli ürünler hariç),
- Bitkisel zamlar ve reçineler,
- İşlenmiş tohum, tuber ve soğanlar (yüksek riskli ürünler hariç),
- Kurutulmuş meyveler (yüksek riskli ürünler hariç),
- Kurutulmuş sebzeler (yüksek riskli ürünler hariç),
- İşlenmemiş bitki ürünleri (taze meyveler, sebzeler, fidanlık stokları, herbaryum örnekleri, taze kesme çiçekler hariç)

Bu kapsamda, yukarıda listelenen ürünler için gerçekleştirilecek her sevkiyatta ihracatçı ülkenin hükümet yetkilileri tarafından, aşağıda sunulan beyanatı içerir bir bitki sağlığı sertifikasının düzenlenmiş olması gerekmektedir.
